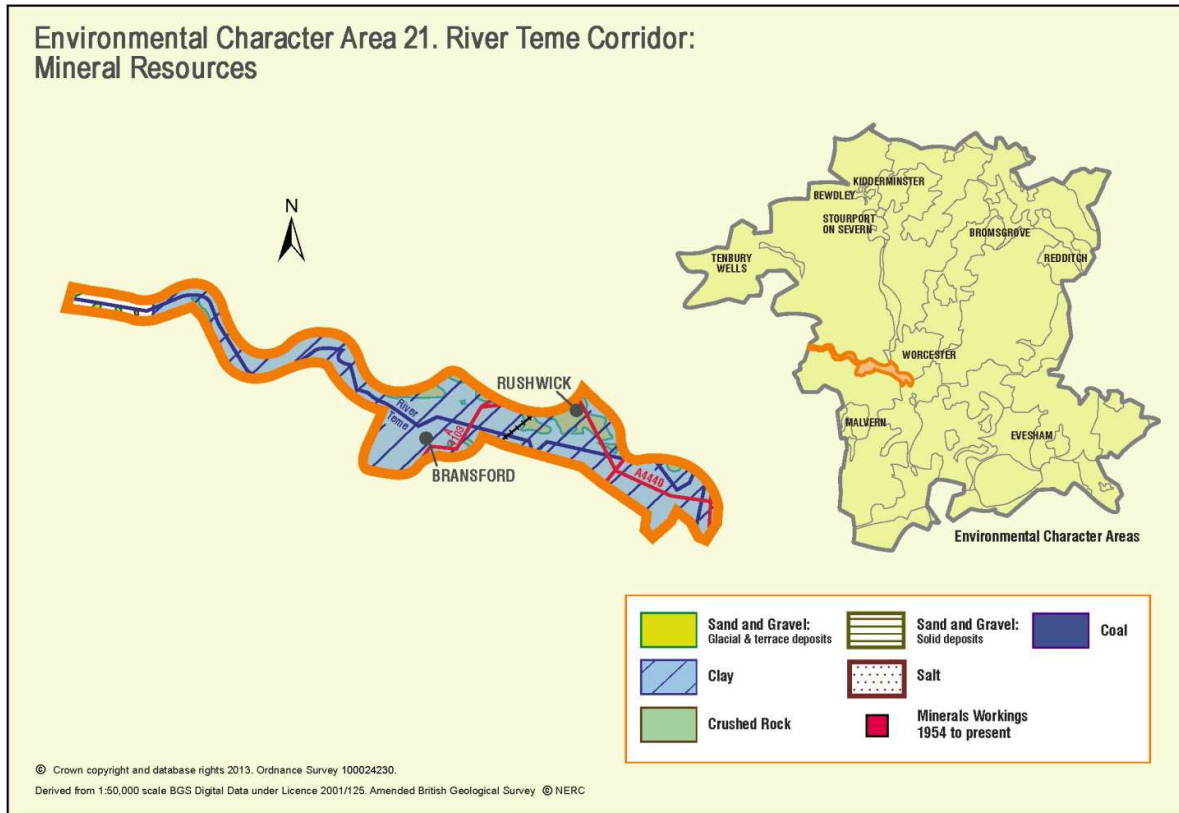


## Appendix 21: Analysis of aggregate resources in ECA 21: River Teme Corridor
