Brief Description of Decision	<p>(a) The outcome of the public consultation as summarised in the report was noted;</p> <p>(b) The relocation of Worcester Resource Centre to Greenhill Lodge in Worcester was approved;</p> <p>(c) The Strategic Director for Adult and Communities was authorised to implement the relocation.</p>
Reason(s) for Decision	To further consolidate provision at Worcester Resource Centre (WRC) into Greenhill Lodge (GHL). There would be no change to the availability of the service provided but would allow the current WRC building to be either repurposed or sold and all available space at Greenhill Lodge to be fully occupied. This will generate further revenue savings and a potential capital receipt.
Alternative Options Considered and Rejected	Stay in the current location (Worcester Resource Centre). This has been rejected as the costs are higher and no potential for capital receipts.
