WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH RP-501 (PARTS), FORMERLY FOOTPATH 1, IN THE PARISH OF RIPPLE)
PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2026

The above Order, made on 15th January 2026. The effect of the order will be to extinguish the public footpath and modify the definitive map and statement for Worcestershire accordingly,

Footpath RP-501 section 1- running from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 8506 4245 (point A on the Order map). The path proceeds in a generally southerly direction, for 90 metres, to OSGR SO 8507 4236 (point B on the Order map)

Footpath RP-501 section 2 - from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 8533 4139 (point C on the Order map). The path proceeds in a generally southerly direction, for 209 metres, to OSGR SO 8539 4119 (point D on the Order map).as shown on the order map.

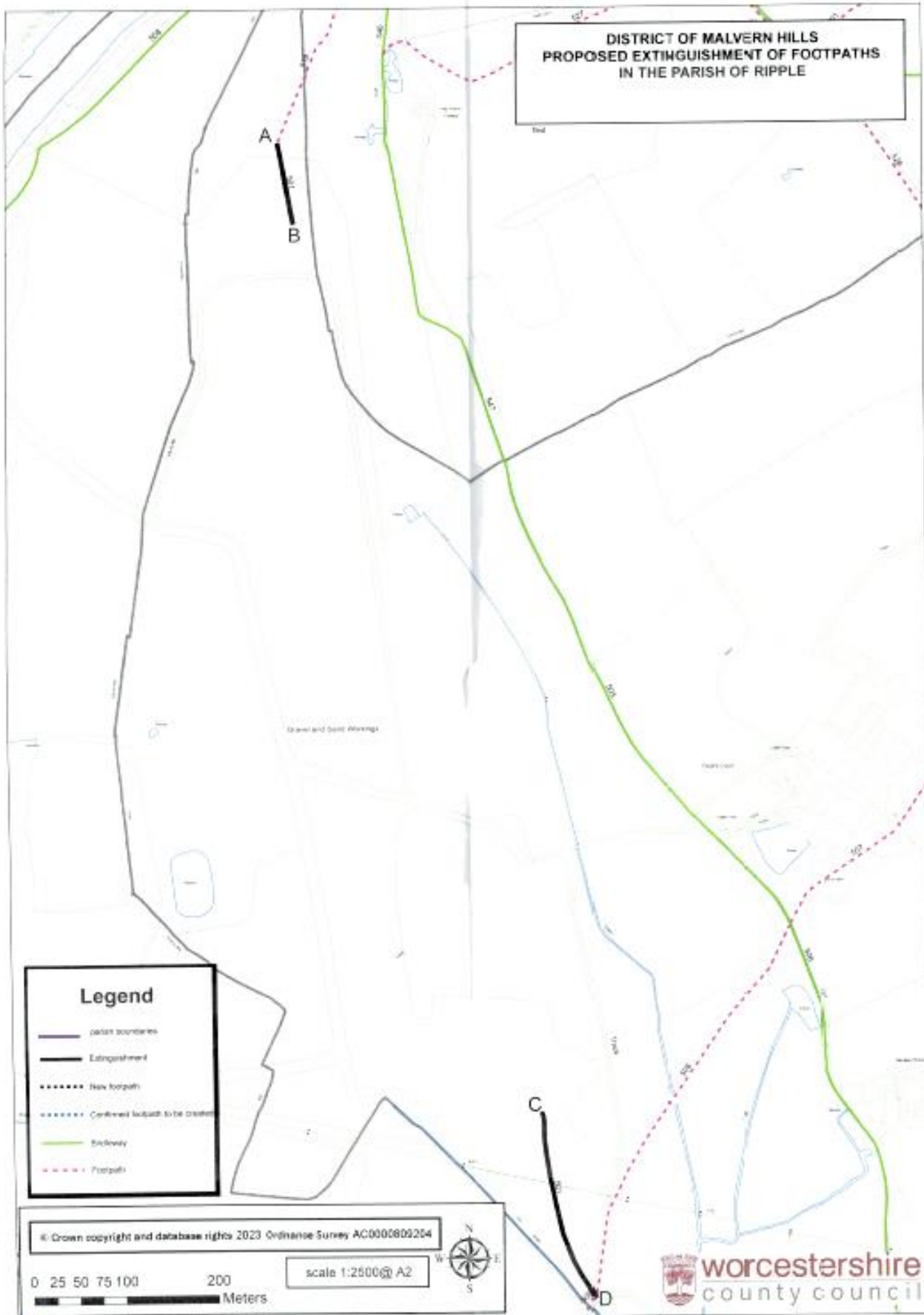

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
