Order Preliminaries

This Order is made by Worcestershire County Council ('the Authority') under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because they are satisfied that it is necessary to stop up parts of the footpath to which this Order relates ('the Footpath') in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely:-

The extraction by surface working of minerals from land by CEMEX UK Operations Limited and to facilitate restoration to agriculture and a lake suitable for water sports in accordance with the planning permission granted by Worcestershire County Council under planning references: 20/000009/CM, 20/000015/CM & M/22/00846/CM.

Articles - By this Order

1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up as provided below.
2. The stopping up of the footpath shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is stopped up there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

Description of site of existing footpath to be stopped up

Footpath RP-501 (Part) - Section 1

The length and entire width of Footpath RP-501 (part), in the parish of Ripple, commencing at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 8506 4245 (point A on the Order map). The path proceeds in a generally southerly direction, for 90 metres, to OSGR SO 8507 4236 (point B on the Order map).

The total distance of footpath to be stopped up is 90 metres.

Footpath RP-501 (Part) - Section 2

The length and entire width of Footpath RP-501 (part), in the parish of Ripple, commencing at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 8533 4139 (point C on the Order map). The path proceeds in a generally southerly direction, for 209 metres, to OSGR SO 8539 4119 (point D on the Order map).

The total distance of footpath to be stopped up is 209 metres.
