Statement of Reasons for proposing to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HURCOTT VILLAGE, KIDDERMINSTER) (30 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (REVOCATION AND PROPOSAL) ORDER 2026

Worcestershire County Council propose to make this Order for facilitating the safe passage on the roads or any other road of any class of traffic and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

It is considered that the Order will contribute to the securing of the expeditious, safe and convenient movement of all traffic (including pedestrians) and will have no adverse effect on other considerations contained in s122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HURCOTT VILLAGE, KIDDERMINSTER) (30 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (REVOCAION AND PROPOSAL) ORDER 2026

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is herein after referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. That The Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Kidderminster Restricted Roads and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2001 (Variation) and the Borough Council of Kidderminster (40 mph speed limit) (No.2) Order 1970 (Revocation) Order 2011 (Revocation), (A451 Broadwaters, Kidderminster to County Boundary) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2012 (Revocation) Various Roads, Kidderminster Restricted Roads and 40mph Speed Limit Order 2001 (Revocation) and (A451 Stourbridge Road, UC12401 Hurcott Road and UC12400 Hurcott Lane, Kidderminster (30 mph and 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2019 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding **30** miles per hour along those roads as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding **50** miles per hour along those roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Hurcott Village, Kidderminster) (30 & 50 mph Speed Limit) (Revocation and Proposal) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on XXXXX 2026

SCHEDULE 1

Hurcott Village, Kidderminster – 30mph Speed Limit

UC12401 Hurcott Road: from a point 35 metres west of its junction with UC12446 (Harriers Green) in an easterly direction for a distance of 115 metres.

UC12400 Hurcott Lane: from a point 157 metres north of its junction with U12401 (Hurcott Road) in a southerly direction to a point 190 metres south of that junction.

UC12401 (Hurcott Road): from its junction with UC12400 (Hurcott Lane) for a distance of 155 metres in a westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

(50 mph Speed Limit)

A451 Stourbridge Road: from a point 223 metres north east of its junction with UC12447 in a north easterly direction to the County Boundary.

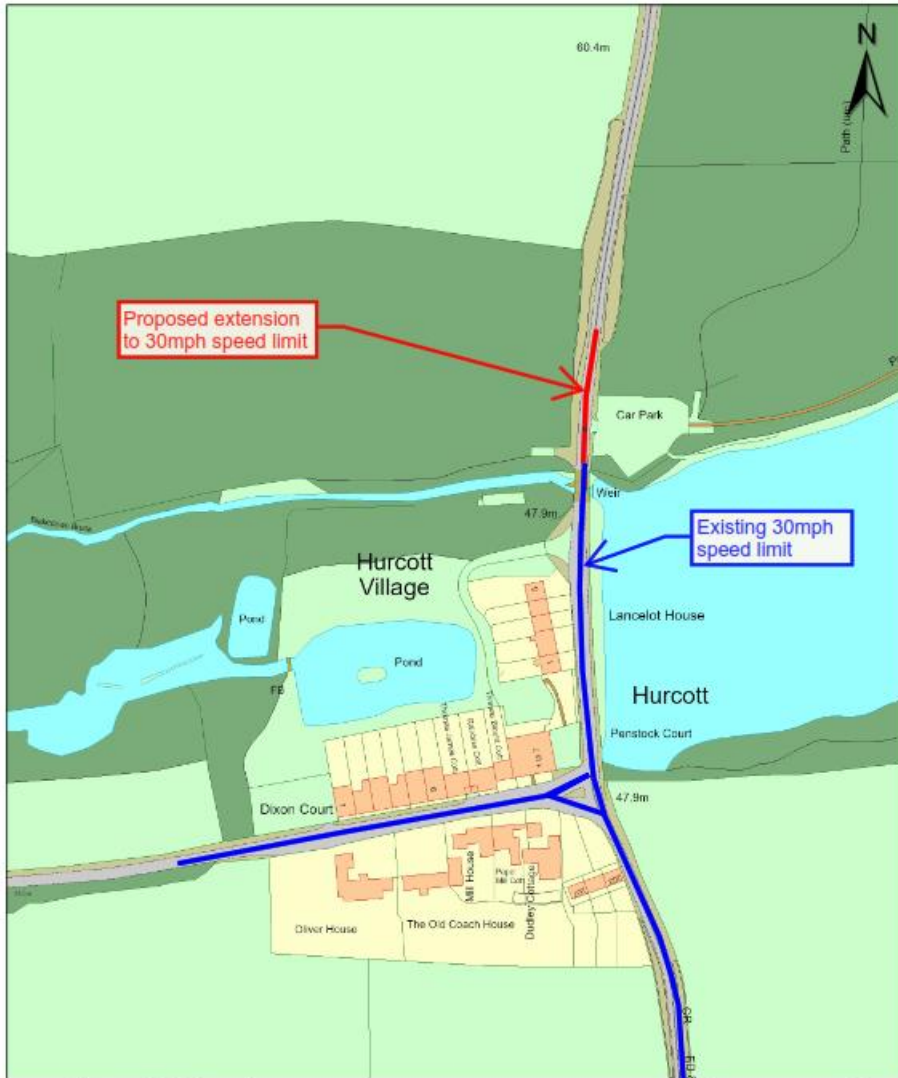
Map and plan of the area
