Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is herein after referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. That The County of Hereford and Worcester (Restricted Roads) (No.1) Order 1981 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
2. That The County of Worcestershire (Various Roads, Beckford) (Restricted Roads) Order 2000 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
3. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along those roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Order shall come into operation on 19 March 2026 and may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Beckford) (30 mph Speed Limit) (Revocation and Proposal) Order 2026

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Order shall come into operation on 19 March 2026 and may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Beckford) (30 mph Speed Limit) (Revocation and Proposal) Order 2026

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967  
THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER  
(RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO. 1) ORDER 1981

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester in exercise of their powers under Section 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby order and direct as follows:-

1. That the following roads and lengths of road in the Parish of Beckford in the District of Mychewton in the County of Hereford and Worcester shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967:
  - i. C. 5 - from a point 130 metres (426 feet) north west of its junction with Rock Lane, in a southerly and easterly direction along Main Street, to a point in Station Road, 50 metres (164 feet) south of its junction with Main Street.
  - ii. Back Lane - from its junction with Main Street (C.5) to its junction with the A435 Evesham - Cheltenham Road.
  - iii. Beckford Grafton Road - from its junction with C.5 Main Street for a distance of 200 metres (656 feet) in a northerly direction.

2. This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Restricted Roads (No. 1) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on the 10th day of February 1981.

1. That roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act of 1984;
2. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Beckford) (Restricted Roads) Order 2000 and shall come into operation on 20 January 2000.

**C2005 (Main Street/Station Road):** from a point 130 metres northwest of its junction with Back Lane to its junction with A46 (T) Cheltenham Road.

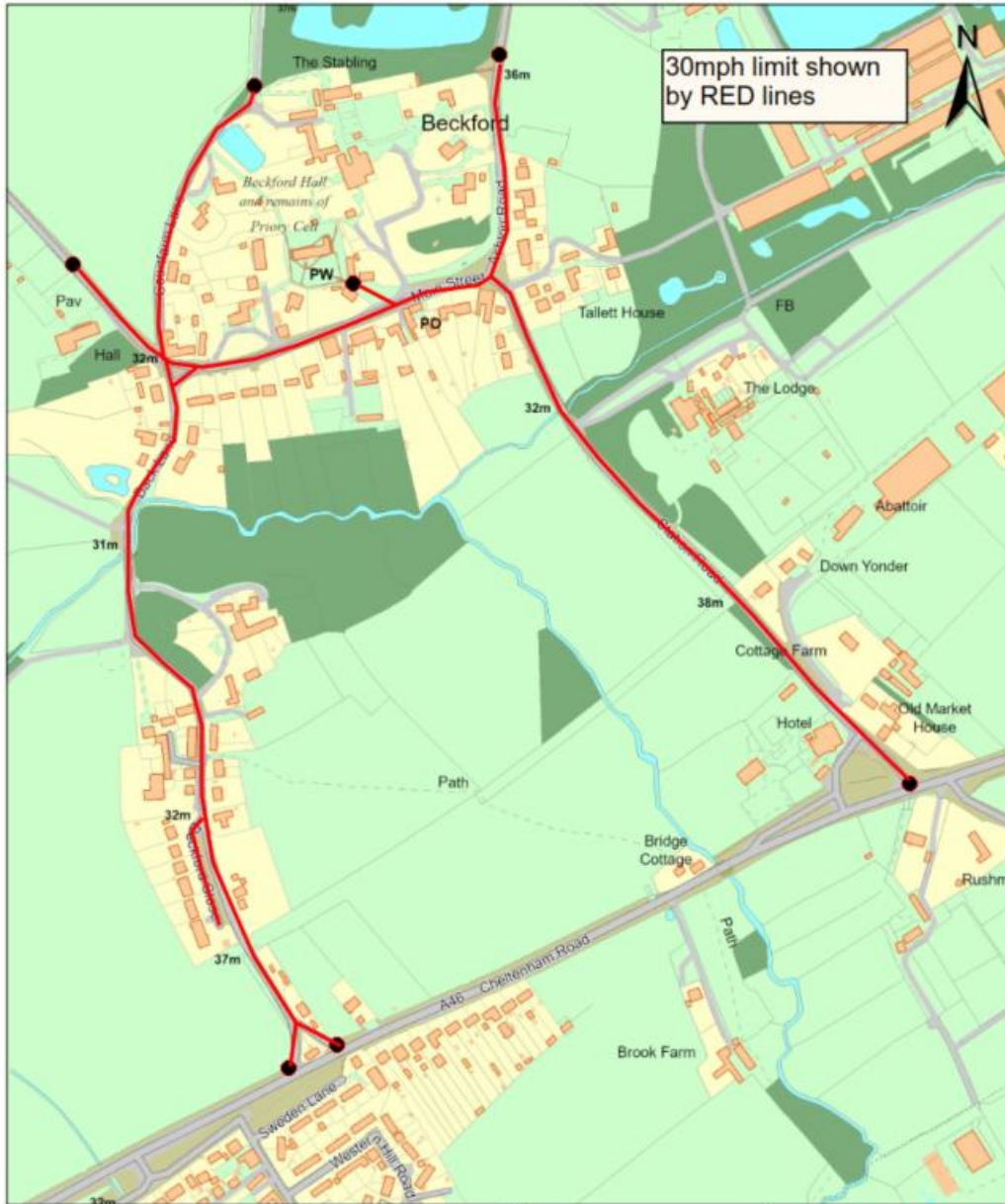
**Back Lane:** for its entire length.
